Planet Joey is a full-length drama that opens during the summer of 1985 in Mars, PA. Joey is an eleven-year-old tomboy and fanatical member of the *Star Wars Fan Club*. Her deepest desire is to become an astronaut and walk on the moon.

When Joey unearths her parent's evil plan to sell the house she grew up in and move to Oakwood, she hatches a counterplan that enlists the help of her best friend, Bonnie 'Officer' Patberg, and her dope-smokin' harmonica-tootin' cousin, Fitz, who has been recruited to help the family pack. Captain Joey shares her 'secret mission' with Admiral Fitzgerald who 'swears to secrecy' in exchange for more information about the sexy next-door neighbor— a stripper named Misty Morning.

Fitz turns to the dark side on the eve of Joey's holy confirmation when Misty Morning unceremoniously dumps him over the phone.
